You Said ... Who are Adlington Town Council.

We have listed our information on this page....

- The list of all our names and contact numbers are on this page. We were all recruited through an open and transparent recruitment process.
- We normally meet on the third Monday of every month in Adlington Library.
- **We are all volunteers** – At town level only the mayor gets a monetary allowance for his/her year in office. Everything else we do is free of charge, attending meetings, supporting local causes, drafting the newsletter, fund raising, rebuilding/maintaining our social media and website pages, representing the town.
- We all live in or within 3 miles of Adlington or own a property or land here.
- We all take up extra positions on the council on its various subgroups and then report back to the main council for a democratic decision.
- We don't have the final say on planning applications, but we can voice opinions to Chorley Borough Council and relay the concerns of the residents
- We have one paid P/T Clerk who helps us with our admin and Financial Management.

You Said ... We are concerned about the planning applications for Houses of Multiple Occupancy (HMO).

We checked the relative information.... Anyone can raise concerns, but the quick answer is that often planning permission is not required to convert a property to an HMO. In England the General Permitted Development Order makes it possible for anyone to change the use of a dwelling house subject to certain limits and conditions. While planning permission is required for those HMOs with more than 6 occupants, those for 5 or less are not subject to the scrutiny of planning permission.
