How to report traffic crime or dangerous situations

Report erratic driving, dangerous loads, unroadworthy vehicles or hazards on the road by phoning **999** as soon as you safely can. Write down the registration number, with a description of the make, colour and, if possible, who was driving. To make the report anonymously call Crimestoppers, a national charity who will pass the information on without asking for your personal details.

If you're involved in a collision take a note of the name, contact details and insurance information of anyone else involved. If someone is injured, or if the road has become blocked, phone **999**. Other collisions should be reported within 24 hours phone **101**. You are not able to make reports through social media.

YOU SAID WE DID.....

You Said ... We are concerned about the planning application of an **Anaerobic Digester Unit** on land within the Adlington Boundary

We ... Held an Open Forum at the September 2024 Adlington Town Council Meeting at which residents were encouraged to give their views and allowed to remain in the meeting while the application was discussed as an agenda item.

Since then, we have compiled a lengthy objection to Lancashire County Council Planning Department. We have included issues raised at the Open Forum. Lancashire County Council have commenced a further consultation regarding this application, because further information has been submitted, and this application comes under environmental impact assessment. Updates can be viewed on our web site, our social media pages and on our notice boards.

You said ... We are concerned that **dog fouling** is an issue that is concerning in several locations in our village.

We said We appreciate that most owners act responsibly when clearing up after their pets, but we ask all dog walkers to be responsible and clear up all dog fouling caused by their dog.

When walking your dog:

- be prepared and take enough bags with you
- clean up after your dog
- put the waste in a dog bin, an ordinary litter bin or take it home with you.

Tackling dog fouling is very important because it is a health concern and one of the biggest concerns for residents. If you spot dog fouling in a public place and spot someone not cleaning up after their dog, please report it to Chorley Council as it can help them to target their activities on this issue. All reports of dog fouling are treated confidentially.
