YOU SAID WE DID.....

You said ... After the disruption we suffered during the changes to accommodate the electrification of the railway line, why have we got a worse and much reduced service instead of the gold service we were promised.

We have written to the lead on local transport at Lancashire County Council on several occasions copying the rail service providers into our correspondence. We have also written to the Minister for Transport at Whitehall. Northern now states that it intends to re-instate the off-peak hourly stopping train service in the December 2022 timetable.

You said... We have great concerns with reference to the amount of large planning application that have been submitted to Chorley Council regarding sites in Adlington,

We have held several open forums at the beginning of each Adlington Council Meeting allowing residents to have their say.

We have listened to your concerns and raised some of our own, these can be viewed on the Chorley planning site. We have also asked that Chorley Council and LCC take a holistic view to planning around the area at the bottom of Railway Road, including the exit from the station, Market Street and Church Street.
